Week Two: Your Kingdom Come In Me

Overview

Have you ever sat down to think about your priorities? If a stranger were to look at your life, what would they say that you placed the emphasis on? Is it your work? Is it money? Is it achievement? Each of us make decisions, whether consciously or without giving it a second thought, to prioritize certain things. In the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus gives us a very different idea of what we should prioritize, and what we should orient our lives around.

Reading and Discussion

- Each of us struggle with priorities. Even if we like to think our priorities are in the right order, how much time we spend doing or thinking about something often gives us a better insight. What are some things that you struggle with over or under-prioritizing?
- **2. Read Matthew 6:25-34.** What stands out to you from this passage? What comforts or challenges you?
- **3.** What does Jesus say that we should prioritize first? How is that different from what the world usually tells us to "seek first?"

- **4.** Jesus invites us to be a part of his Kingdom now. What are some practical ways that you can seek first His Kingdom and his ways this week?
- **5.** As you close, pray the Lord's Prayer together with your group: Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as in heaven. Give us today our daily bread. Forgive us our sins as we forgive those who sin against us. Lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil. For yours is the kingdom, the power, and the glory forever and ever. Amen.
