Week Four: Your Kingdom Come Around Us

Overview

In the final week of this series, we prayed for God's Kingdom to come in the world around us. We discussed the idea of mission, and saw through scripture that God has prepared each of us to join him in his mission of reconciling people back to himself. It's an exciting thing to partner with God in what he's doing. Let's live with the Kingdom in mind, and let's look for those opportunities to serve, love, and share each day.

Reading and Discussion

- 1. Open this session up by checking in with everyone. Ask everyone to share, if they can, one place in which they saw God move in the past week.
- 2. This week, we discussed the idea of mission. **Read Acts 1:6-11.** Put yourself in the Apostles' shoes. What about Jesus' message to them in this moment would excite you? What about it might make you nervous?
- 3. Read **1 Corinthians 5:18-21.** What stands out to you from this passage?
- 4. Kaleb noted that we are all ambassadors for Jesus and his Kingdom. Ambassadors are sent by their country to learn the culture and the people in a new land, build positive relationships

with the people, and to work towards advancing the interests and values of the country that sent them. What is one direct way that you can begin to approach your days from this point of view – living as an ambassador for God's Kingdom?

5. As you close, pray the Lord's Prayer together with your group: Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as in heaven. Give us today our daily bread. Forgive us our sins as we forgive those who sin against us. Lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil. For yours is the kingdom, the power, and the glory forever and ever. Amen.
