Out of Darkness

Week Three: When God Shows Up

Overview

Exodus is the story of God's saving work in freeing his people from Egypt. It's also the story of God's work in our own lives, freeing us from the power of sin and death – and freeing us to new life in his Kingdom.

This week we discussed Exodus 3 – where God shows up and reveals himself to Moses. In the giving of God's name, we learn who God is: the creator of the universe who sees his people, hears their cry, and saves them. It's in the truth of who God is that we learn the truest part of our own identity: that we are his children.

Reading and Discussion

1. Read Exodus 3:1-15. What stands to you from this passage upon first reading?
2. Where are you searching to find your identity?
3. What lies do you believe about yourself? Positive or negative?
4. What about knowing God changes the way you see your identity?
5. As you close, pray that God will strengthen you in your identity in him – that you may trust and walk in the identity that you have as his child.
