Pray and Discuss:

1. Jesus gave his disciples a new command. He taught them to love one another, just as he loved them. The love of Christ is the most powerful force in all of creation. As you begin, pray that you will be able to experience Christ's love and that God will shape you and lead you to people whom you can share that love with.
2. Read **1 Corinthians 13**. What comes to your mind as you read this passage?
3. Think about the various relationships in your life. Ron mentioned in his message that the goal of parenting should be discipling kids and leading them to relationship

restoration. God took the first step to restore the relationship with humanity, and through Christ's life, death, and resurrection – the relationship is restored between us and God. In what ways do you find relationship restoration difficult in your own life? What is easy about it? How does love compel you to seek restoration?

4. Is there a story from your life that comes to mind when you think about the idea of relationship restoration? Share, if you feel comfortable.
5. As you close, pray that God may bring a person or situation to mind that you need to seek restoration for through his love.
